Saturday 8a-12p Novice/Open Skills and Drills

This session will be for dogs competing in the Novice and Open Level Classes (or about ready to start competing). There will be discussion on handling short sequences and building the framework for a successful agility career. Possibility of all obstacles being used.

Saturday 1230p-430p Masters

Coursework/Sequencing

Masters Level Course Work will be the focus of this session. Kyle will help tackle the challenges and skills needed to effectively move through a Masters Level Agility Course. Kyle will help break down the sequences in order to find the best line for you and your partner. Must be able to sequence 6-8 obstacles and have all needed skills to compete on all obstacles.

Sunday 8a-12p Novice/Open Skills and Drills

This session will focus on building obstacle commitment skills in order to help the handler confidently and quickly execute needed crosses down the course. Distance work will be a product of the session, as well as, being able to efficiently work your way through the course while trusting your dog in the process. Possibility of all obstacles being used.

Sunday 12:30-4:30p- 30 Min Private Lessons

The final session of the weekend will be private lessons with Kyle tailored to you and your dog's needs. These lessons will be in 30 min time slots starting at 12:30-4:30. ACE will assign a time slot based on first come first served.
