Entries Open on:

When premium is available

Entries Close on:

September 8, 2025

Crating available:

Crating indoors, waterproof tarp or mat required under crates and chairs

Due to the surface of the crating area, no anti slip products (other than plain water) are allowed

Entry Limits:

350 per day

Move ups:

Move ups allowed from day to day. No same day move ups.

Day of show Entries:

Day of show entries allowed until trial is filled. Entries taken until 30 minutes before the trial starts.

Refunds:

Entries withdrawn before the closing date will receive a full refund.

Entries withdrawn after the closing date due to injury and/or illness (human/canine) and/or a bitch coming into season will be eligible for a refund – less the \$3 fee for NADAC and judges fee. A doctor/veterinarian note of injury/illness will be required for a refund.

No entry fees will be refunded if a dog and/or handler are dismissed from the competition, regardless of the reason. See summary of NADAC rules for other circumstances under which entry fees will not be refunded.

The Agility Club of Evansville does not own the show venue. Excessive “accidents” in the ring risk us not being able to rent the facility and threatens our ability to host agility trials in the future. There will be a \$25 fee charged for fouling the turf.

Awards and Ribbons:

NADAC ribbons will be awarded for qualifying runs and to first through fourth places in all jump heights in all classes. Rosettes will be awarded for those finishing a title. Special rosettes are available for NADAC awards (e.g. Triple Superior, Versatility, NATCH).

Please let us know (in advance) if you expect to earn a NATCH (or V-NATCH) at the trial so we can celebrate with one of our special NATCH ribbons.

Equipment info: NADAC specific equipment

“The trial you are entering may use slatted contacts. For many years slats have NOT been used in NADAC trials. The reasons for this is that with the lowered height of the NADAC A-frame, and the advent of rubber coated equipment, NADAC found that slats became entirely useless in the sport. As the dogs had more than enough grip with the rubber coatings. NADAC was the first organization to use rubber contacts, and we feel that the removal of slats was the correct and logical next move. The reason we are allowing slats is to encourage new clubs to try NADAC, this way they do not have to purchase a specific set of equipment for NADAC. And to help struggling clubs who can't afford the NADAC spec contacts. The new generation of slats are not a danger to dogs like the old generation was, so while they are not needed for dogs competing in NADAC, it won't hurt to have them either. It should be noted that any Regional or Championship event that you attend with NADAC will be using non slatted contacts.”

All dogs need to be measured.

(effective Jan.1, 2025)

Dogs cannot be officially measured before 2 years old but, must be measured by the time they are competing in Elite.

JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. <https://www.nadac.com/register-your-dog/> A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (ziplock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but it cannot be used during your run, nor can you indicate to the dog it is there. Handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitor's Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), **Agility Club of Evansville** (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and Metro Sports (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons

Entries must be signed and be accompanied by the correct entry fees to be valid.
